BE ORDERED BY THE CITY OF DORCHESTER:

That an election is to be held on Saturday, May 6, 2023, for the purpose of electing Mayor, and three Aldermen. They are the seats currently held by David Smith, James Stewart, Justin Raner, and Vince Hagaard

That said election will be conducted by the Grayson County Elections Administration and will be held at the following places:

Howe Community Center, 700 W Haning, Howe, Tx

Dorchester City Hall, 373 Main St. Dorchester, Tx. In the event City of Dorchester does not hold an election the Dorchester site will not be open.

Becky Vincent, City Secretary for the City of Dorchester is hereby appointed Election Manager and overseer for said election and shall be in charge of procedures governing said election.

That it is hereby ordered that early voting shall begin on April 24, 2023, and continue through April 28, 2023 at the Howe Community Center, 700 W Haning, Howe, Tx. Voting will be available Monday, April 24, 2023 – Friday, April 28, 2023 between the hours of 8:00am till 5:00pm and Monday, May 1—Tuesday, May 2, between the hours 7:00am-7:00pm.

All workers will be appointed by the Grayson County Elections Administration. This includes all presiding judges, clerks, judge of Central County and judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board.

The ballots shall be translated into Spanish, eliminating the need to appoint an interpreter for said election.

The method for voting in said election shall be by Electronic Touch Screen Voting Machines.

The Grayson County Elections Administration will be designated as the Central Counting Station for tabulating the voted ballots of said election.

The manner of holding said election shall be governed, as near as may be, by Election Code of this State, and the City of Dorchester will furnish all necessary ballots and other election supplies requisite to said election.

The President shall cause a Notice of Election to be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the county where the city is located. Said publication shall be not more that 30 days or less than 10 days before the date of said election.
